

The Pottawatomie County Board of County Commissioners met in a regular meeting on Tuesday, June 24, 2025 at 9:00 a.m. The following members were present: Melissa Dennis, Chairman, Abby Thompson and Greg Rush, Members, Raeshel Flewallen, County Clerk, Stacy Bateman-Woods, ADA, were present at today's meeting.

PUBLIC COMMENTS- No one addressed the Board under "Public Comments".

UPDATE FACILITIES MAINTENANCE- There were 46 maintenance tasks and 3 pm's completed.

UPDATE PUBLIC SAFETY CENTER- The current number of inmates is 306. There are 258 males and 48 females. Eighty-two were booked-in and 71 released. Five inmates were placed on safety observations.

UPDATE POTT CO 911- There were 11 address points created/edited. Four edits to centerlines were done.

UPDATE POTT COUNTY EM- There was one drone response. Fourteen people applied for the vacant Deputy Director position. Ten storm shelters were registered on OneMap. Assistance was given during the Blackberry Festival.

UPDATE POTT CO SHERIFF'S OFFICE- During May there were 264 warnings, 94 citations, and 183 case numbers. In June there were 207 warnings, 153 citations and 126 case numbers. They helped at the Blackberry Festival and will be present during the IFYR.
