

The Pottawatomie County Board of County Commissioners met in a regular meeting on Tuesday, October 28, 2025 at 9:00 a.m. The following members were present: Abby Thompson and Greg Rush, Members, Raeshel Flewallen, County Clerk, Stacy Bateman-Woods, ADA.

PUBLIC COMMENTS- No one addressed the Board under "Public Comments".

UPDATE FACILITIES MAINTENANCE- There were 46 work tasks with 1 pm.

UPDATE PUBLIC SAFETY CENTER- The current number of inmates is 321. There are 270 males and 51 females. Fifty-seven were booked-in and 63 released. Two were placed on safety observations.

UPDATE POTT CO 911- There were 13 address points created/edited.

UPDATE POTT COUNTY EM- There were 2 new shelters mapped on OneMap. Sartech II training has been completed. They attended CPN Trunk or Treat and will also be assisting with Fall Fest.

UPDATE POTT COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE- There are 2 deputies in driver's training and a new vehicle has been ordered.
