

The Pottawatomie County Board of County Commissioners met in a regular meeting on Tuesday, May 5, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. The following members were present: Melissa Dennis, Chairman, Abby Thompson and Greg Rush, Members, Stephanie Hutchcraft, 1st Deputy County Clerk, Stacy Bateman-Woods, ADA.

PUBLIC COMMENTS- Daniel Johnson, Shawnee Forward, stated they would be holding a business before hours tomorrow from 8:00- 9:30 a.m.

UPDATE FACILITIES MAINTENANCE- There were 71 maintenance tasks including 1 pm. Revisions to plans for 15 East 10 are ongoing.

UPDATE PUBLIC SAFETY CENTER- The current number of inmates is 324. There are 264 females and 60 males. Fifty-nine were booked-in and 64 released. Five inmates were placed on safety observations.

UPDATE POTT CO 911- There were 81 address points created/edited and 10 center lines created/edited.

UPDATE POTT COUNTY EM- Two shelters were mapped on OneMap. They are working on a flooding problem on Clearpond Dr. A site survey and quote from ALCOM are being done at 19123 Industrial Park Dr.
